

Graduate Nurse Program




Our graduates

The Graduate Nurse Program is a 12 month program, consisting of two six month rotations.

Our program is fully supported and provides:

- extensive educational opportunities across all specialties, some which transition into a post graduate certificate in nursing

There are two different streams within the program – clinical and peri-operative. You may choose either stream.

Clinical Stream – areas include:

- + Dialysis*
- + General Surgery, Colorectal & Hepatobiliary
- + Neuroscience
- + Oncology**
- + Orthopaedics
- + Palliative Care
- + Rehabilitation
- + Respiratory

- + Women's Health. Plastics & Vascular
- * after 6 months **you may specialise your program in oncology Intensive Care, Emergency and Anaesthetics positions may be available after completing the Graduate Nurse Program.

Peri-operative Stream:

- + Operating Theatre (Scrub/Scout), commencing first rotation and offered as a full year placement only
 - -Anaesthetic
- + Post-Anaesthetic Care Unit (Recovery) & Anaesthetics, commencing second rotation only, 6 months in each area commencing in PACU.
