- Dysphagia refers to difficulties chewing and swallowing food, drink, medications and/or saliva
- Communication difficulties include barriers to speech, hearing, writing, reading, and difficulties with language, symbols and gestures

Blue Care's experienced Speech Pathologists are committed to supporting individuals, families and care givers to manage dysphagia/communication difficulties and maintain daily activities and lifestyles.

The typical care needs our Speech Pathologist can provide support with include:

- Assisting with communication rehabilitation following a stroke
- Providing communication strategies and aids to support people experiencing communication difficulties

- Assessing and assisting with difficulties in chewing and swallowing
- Maintaining and improving voice function
- Identifying hearing difficulties and referral to Audiology
- Guiding communication strategies that improve interactions between carers and people with dementia
