



Bridge replacement and road works

Redbank Road, Tiaro

Queensland Rail will be replacing the timber rail bridge at Redbank Road, Tiaro with a new concrete structure during a scheduled rail closure between 4 and 6 June 2016. Following this bridge replacement, works will be undertaken on Redbank Road to lower and widen the road at the bridge location.

Redbank Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Road closed from Friday 3 June for approximately four weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Lowering and widening of Redbank Road under the rail bridge <p>This work requires a traffic detour around the Redbank Road work site via Kooringa Road for the full construction period. Detour signage and traffic control will be in place.</p>

Queensland Rail is aware noise and lighting from such operations may cause temporary inconvenience to our valued neighbours. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption.
