



Burnett River bridge remediation

Works update – February 2016

Queensland Rail is undertaking remediation works on a series of rail bridges on the North Coast Line in Central Queensland. Project works are underway on bridges over Burnett River and Kolan River in the Bundaberg area and Boyne River in Gladstone.

These works are necessary to ensure that safe, timely and adequate rail services continue to be provided to the region.

Upcoming activities planned for the Burnett River rail bridge are outlined in the table below.
