



SPEECH PATHOLOGY REFERRAL GUIDE WORKSHOP EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATORS AND CARERS

- What is the best age to refer a child to speech pathology?

- What speech sound errors are typical in a 4 year old?

This two-hour workshop is aimed at promoting the benefits of accessing speech pathology services for babies, toddlers and young children. The workshop is highly recommended for early childhood educators and workers to raise the awareness of the importance of helping children with speech and language development before school entry.
